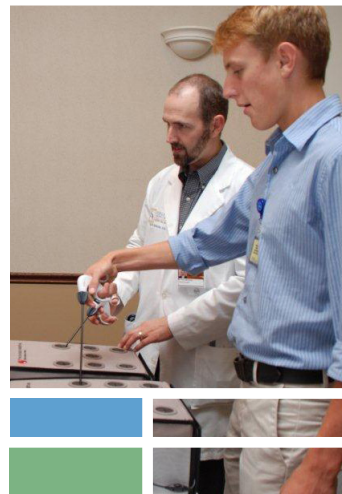
This summer program is designed for college students, 2016 high school graduates and high school students who will be seniors in Fall 2016.

### Requirements for Clinical Observation

Students who participate in the clinical experiences must:

1. Complete a confidentiality acknowledgement and HIPAA packet, along with safety education and a safety test.
2. Obtain or document TB screening from one of the following:
  - Two-step TB in the past year.
  - TB tests in the past two consecutive years.
  - Receive a free TB test at Aultman Health Services in the hospital on June 20 or 21 only and have it checked during the symposium on June 23. Receive the required second free TB test at least one week after the first TB test. The two-step TB test must be completed and checked before you can observe.
  - Aultworks (330-491-9675 for locations, dates and times) \$13 each test.
  - Contact your primary care physician for information.
3. Attend the June 23 Summer Symposium and one of the Post-Observation Sessions — (Dates to be determined).
4. Follow the Aultman dress code and code of conduct.
