when soil was warm, sunlight glorious.

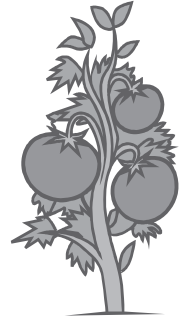
She watered them religiously
