- 4. At the end of the outline, before the conclusion, we have inserted a section for possible counter arguments.
 - . This section could be moved to another part of your essay.
 - . Ask your instructor where he/she wants you to consider counter arguments.
 - . Counter arguments are arguments AGAINST your position, so you need to respond to them -- tell your readers why your thesis is still the correct position.
