Criteria for Award

Ame and Karen Duncan are pleased to announce the second annual CEO's Service Leader Scholarship Awards. Two graduating seniors from Chicago Public Schools will receive a \$2,500.00 scholarship award to be applied to the college of their choice. Any senior in Chicago Public Schools is eligible to apply provided that he/she has achieved a 3.0 G.P.A. and meets the criteria listed below. The CEO's Service Leader Scholarship Award will recognize two students who personify the qualities of an individual who is dedicated to his/heracademics, school, community, and society. Specifically, the award will recognize the students who have excelled in academics and participated in extra-curricular and community activities. Students who have demonstrated a commitment to their own leadership development, exhibited civic skills, and contributed to the common good in school and community through effective action are encouraged to apply.

In order to apply, students should complete the enclosed application form and list one reference person (school faculty, religious leader, community leader) who will agree to be interviewed as part of the application process. Ten applicants will be chosen as finalists and their chosen references will be interviewed in order to determine the award winners.

- 1. The applicant will have demonstrated a commitment to developing as a well-munded individual through an appropriate balance of academics (minimum 3.0 G.P.A.), extra-c urricular activities, community participation, and/or work.
- 2. Student will have demonstrated a commitment to his/herown leadership by having sought out opportunities to develop new leadership skills.
- 3. Student will have demonstrated civic leadership skills through organizing a service or action project that responds to a critical community need.
- 4. Student will have demonstrated a commitment to the common good through action in school and/or community.

Application Procedures

Outstanding students who have proven their effectiveness as leaders in their school and community are encouraged to apply for the CEO's Service Leader Award. Applicants must:

- complete the enclosed application coversheet,
- submit a 2-3 page essay which responds in detail to the criteria listed above,
- identify an adult who will agreed to be interviewed as part of the review process, and
- sub mit the application by the dead line of Friday, April 1, 2005.

Finalists will be announced on April 30, 2004, and two winners will be announced at the Service-Learning Coach Recognition Event in May. Please return completed application to:
