The following is a summary of the general nature and level of work performed by the staff member in this position. This description is not designed to contain, or be interpreted as, a comprehensive inventory of all duties and responsibilities. Other duties may be assigned.

Every employee at the Washington State Convention Center Public Facilities District (WSCC) works closely with our visitors and guests. We hire employees who enjoy greeting, listening and responding to these guests. All work is done with a smile and each employee is responsible for making a good first impression and knowing WSCC service standards. Consistently delivering quality service is our number one priority.

The successful candidate will assist the Event Services and Operations departments in fulfilling manual tasks relating to setting meeting rooms, event maintenance and custodial duties at the facility. Essential duties and responsibilities include the following:

- Set up/tear down tables, chairs, risers and related equipment in meeting rooms and exhibit spaces
- Push/pull loaded carts of tables and chairs, material boxes, and freight. Operate large air walls and push/pull them into set-up configurations
- Operate motorized equipment to include, but not be limited to: vacuum cleaners, pallet jacks, forklifts, buffers, scrubbers, backpack blowers, carpet cleaning equipment and driving/riding sweepers
- Perform general event maintenance on the interior and exterior of the facility, to include, but not be limited to: cleaning rest rooms, trash removal and vacuuming
- Act upon concerns and/or complaints from guests (referring them to the appropriate supervisor when necessary)
- Respond to guestions and inquiries about event activities in WSCC
- Effectively use a two-way radio for communication with various departments within WSCC

Individuals hired into this position must serve a probationary period of six months. During the first 10 work shifts, the hourly wage will be 85 percent (\$14.59) of the hourly wage listed above. Union membership is not required during the application process, but will be required within 30 days of the first day of employment. Education/Training

High school diploma or general education degree (GED). Additional experience in custodial and/or event set-up activities may be substituted for a high school diploma or GED.

Experience/Skills

A minimum of six months experience in a hospitality or event environment is preferred.

This position requires the ability to:

- React calmly and productively in various situations and respond to multiple questions and inquiries in a professional, pleasant manner.
- Maintain a team-oriented, working relationship with co-workers, subcontractors and quests.
- Read and interpret documents such as safety rules or operating and procedure manuals
- Write simple correspondence.
- Communicate effectively with co-workers, guests and clients.
- Carry out general to detailed instructions furnished in written, oral, diagram or schedule form.
- Add and subtract three-digit numbers and to multiply and divide.

Age, loss of limb, or other physical impairment, which does not in fact incapacitate, shall not be deemed to disqualify them, provided they provide the capacity necessary to discharge the duties of the position involved: PROVIDED, that spouses of honorably discharged veterans who have served connected permanent and total disability shall also be preferred for appointment and employment.
