Discover innovative ways to incorporate STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, and Math) in your classroom!

With Yellowstone National Park as the venue, learn how to use both traditional and innovative methods to incorporate Art into STEM lessons. Explore new ideas and strategies while networking with other educators on best practices for cross-curricular design.

DAY ONE will include an evening orientation with Yellowstone Association (YA) and National Park Service (NPS) staff.

THE FOLLOWING THREE DAYS will immerse you in Yellowstone's wonders and inspire you with hands-on activities you can use with students. After breakfast each day, YA and NPS instructors will guide you through a mix of classroom lessons and field activities. We will use evening sessions and time with guest experts to further integrate art with STEM and give you tools to engage a variety of learning styles in your classroom. One session of early morning wildlife watching will also be included.

ON THE FINAL MORNING we will discuss ways to incorporate Yellowstone STEAM in your classroom, and create individual action plans.

Meals and lodging are provided. \$100 registration fee is required if you are selected to attend. Following the course, teachers who submit a final project will be awarded a \$200 stipend. Semester credits or renewal units available for additional fees.
