#### Mcclinchy Mile Bicycle Ride March 20 in Arlington

Start your 2016 training with a scenic, wellsupported bicycle ride in Arlington, WA B.I.K.E.S. Club of Snohomish County invites you to explore the rural roads and quiet trails north of the Stillaguamish River Valley north of Seattle.

How far is a McClinchy Mile? That's up to you. Choose from flat or hilly routes: 34, 48, 52 or 100 miles. We'll be there rain or shine – how about you?

Food stops every 15-20 miles (including hot drinks!). Mechanical and vehicle SAG support on all routes.

Cost is \$35 on the day of the ride, or save \$5 by signing up early. First 200 registrants get a reflective McClinchy backpack.

McClinchy Mile supports recreational bicycling, advocacy, and bike-related local grants through B.I.K.E.S. Club of Snohomish County. We have hosted the ride for more than 30 years. Riders can register and start from 8 - 10 a.m. Sunday, March 20. The course closes at 4 p.m. Learn more about the ride at bikesclub.org/ mcclinchy
