PROGRAM PHILOSOPHY AND GOALS

REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

The registration period begins with the new school year. A \$10.00/family, non-refundable registration fee is required to enter into the program. Please submit the following along with your check for the total amount and send back to school with your child upon entering the program:

(2) EMERGENCY MEDICAL FORM/ea child

Students participating in **Enrichment Classes only** <u>must be registered</u> and pay the \$10.00 registration fee. An emergency medical form must be completed for each child in our care whether a full-time participant or an occasional enrichment class student. PROGRAM COST

Students must be paid and registered with a medical form on file prior to service or on the day of service <u>no exceptions</u>. If your child is scheduled on a day he is out sick, please call ASEP @412-661-5633 to report his absence. Parents who do not pick up their children by 6:00 pm will incur a late fee of \$10.00 per 15 minute interval to be paid directly to the teacher at the time of pickup.

One student - \$5/hr or \$12/day Two or more students/family - \$7/hr or \$16/day

EARLY DISMISSAL DAYS: Monday - Friday 11:30/12:30 - 6 pm

One student - \$5.00/hr or \$18/day Two or More students/family - \$7/hr or \$24/day
