Research shows that youth with higher levels of self-determination have better adult outcomes. Working with adolescents in an empowering and self-determined way may be easier said than done. This training will be a collaborative and participatory experience for professionals interested in learning specific skills and techniques from *Take Charge for the Future*, a curriculum that has been found to be effective among youth with diverse disabilities. Learn how to modify *Take Charge for the Future* to fit your work environment. Hear a **panel of youth** who have experienced *Take Charge for the Future* share their experiences with the curriculum.

About the Trainers: <u>Alison Turner</u>, M.Ed., Portland State University Senior Research Associate, has worked in the field of youth self determination for 20 years and managed the National Youth leadership Network. In addition, Alison co-developed *Take Charge for the Future*, which is currently used by federally funded research grants.

<u>Summer Pommier-Satya</u>, MSW, Portland State University Research Associate, has worked for six years on federal grants related to self-determination and youth with disabilities. Currently, her work focuses on the link between self-determination and adult outcomes for youth in foster care with disabilities.
