The number of girls a day camp can register depends on the number of adult volunteer staff members. Volunteers are needed as unit and assistant leaders, program staff, security people (roamers) and bus stop attendants.

As an incentive for trained, full-time (the entire week) day camp volunteers – their children will receive a discounted rate but must pay to participate in any special activities listed on the chart, and for bus transportation if offered.

- Unit Leader – help girls plan, carry out and evaluate a program of outdoor activities; supervise work of the unit staff.
- Assistant Unit Leader – assists unit leader in planning, teaching and coordinating unit activities.
- Program Consultants – provide supplementary activities in special areas, sharing special skills, or talents and serving as a resource for ideas.
- Preschool Unit Leader – provides interesting and safe program and supervision for children of staff, ages 3-5 years.
- Boys Unit Leader – provides interesting and safe program and supervision for school-age sons of staff.
- Security Roamer – provides security for the day camp site. Spends the day walking the perimeter of the site and providing intra-camp communication.
- Health Supervisor – supervises and is responsible for the general health and safety of campers and staff. Must be a certified First Aid, Adult/Child CPR, and/or CPR/AED.
- Bus Monitor – supervises campers at bus stop, checks them on and off the bus and verifies absences.
- Bus Proctor – gets on day camp bus at first bus stop and supervises campers on ride to and from camp.
