BRIAN McINTOSH HEAD COACH

Coach McIntosh has spent the past 5 years as the Assistant Women's Basketball Coach at Emporia State University. In those 5 years, McIntosh has helped compile an overall record of 125-36. He helped lead the Lady Hornets to four NCAA DII Sweet 16 Appearances including a Final Four finish this past season. The Lady Hornets advanced to the MIAA Tournament Championship game in all five of his years, winning the last three titles.

A 2000 graduate of Emporia State, McIntosh has six years of head coaching experience and four years' experience as an assistant at the high school level. He spent two seasons prior to ESU, rebuilding the Shawnee Mission Northwest girls program, improving their win total each year. He also led the Madison High School Boys Basketball team to a regional championship and two appearances in the Class 1A sub state tournament.
