#### Kirkland Museum of Fine & Decorative Art

displays a major collection of international decorative art from about 1875 to about 1990. More than 3,500 works are shown from every major design period from Arts & Crafts to Postmodern. About 700 works by more than 230 Colorado and regional artists are on view. The Colorado and regional art collection is concerned with a period from 1820 to about 1990 (traditional through modern), with an emphasis on the 1850s onwards. The museum also features a retrospective of Colorado's distinguished painter, Vance Kirkland (1904–1981). All three collections are housed in a 1911 Arts & Crafts building, formerly Kirkland's art school and studio, which will be relocated from 1311 Pearl Street to become a central part of the new museum experience. Kirkland Museum is a member of Historic Artists' Homes and Studios, a program of the National Trust for Historic Preservation.
