Content:

- 1. The typed essay is to be a minimum of 500 words but not to exceed 1000 words.
- 2. The topic is clearly addressed.
- 3. Ideas are developed and support the topic.
- 4. The writing demonstrates a sense of completeness.

Grammatical Structure:

- 1. Free of run-on sentences and sentence fragments.
- 2. Correct subject/verb agreement and verb tense.
- 3. Correct use of singular and plural noun forms.
- 4. Correct/appropriate use of punctuation
- 5. Appropriate/ correct word choice.
- 6. Free of spelling errors.

Organization:

1. The ideas flow and fit together.

- 2. The details are sequential in logical order
- 3. The writing has a clear beginning, middle, and end.
- 4. The ideas are presented in varied and innovative use of words, phrases, and sentences.
