FIELD USE GUIDELINES

- During weekdays, field conditions will be evaluated in the early afternoon and any field closings will be determined by 3:00 p.m. Decision is subject to change based on changing weather conditions.
- On weekends, holidays, and high school game days, field conditions will be evaluated in the early morning and any field closings will be determined by 8 a.m. and by 12 p.m. for high school play. Decision is subject to change based on changing weather conditions.
- Field status is determined by Recreation Director or Highway Supervisor. On weekends and holidays the fields may be evaluated by League Administrators when designated.
- The Town of Harwinton maintains the fields, therefore no alterations may be made to the fields.
- Field users are responsible for cleaning litter from all areas and depositing litter in trash receptacles or recycling containers, prior to departing.
- The Supervising Person should make sure the area is vacated by dusk, the gate is closed & locked.

Top 5 Signs Fields Are Unsuitable for Play

- 1. Ground is squishy or waterlogged
- 2. Fields have standing puddles of water
- 3. Grass is easily pulled out of the ground
- 4. Footing is unsure or slippery
- 5. Weather is severe-including, but not limited to thunder &/or lightning

When fields are used under these conditions, it can often cause irreversible damage to fields. It takes months, sometimes years, for fields to recover. It is also unsafe for participants.

If you arrive to find any of these conditions present-do not allow players on the field!

RULES FOR USE

- 1. Area open Dawn to Dusk
- 2. Harwinton Recreation Department approved activities only
- 3. Stay off fields that are unsuitable for play
- 4. All persons using this facility do so at their own risk
- 5. All children must be supervised
- 6. Stay off fences
- 7. Keep fields & surrounding areas clean use trash bins and recycle containers
- 8. Spectators are not permitted on playing fields
- 9. The following are prohibited:

Smoking

Dogs & Domesticated Animals

Snowmobiles/ATV's

Golf

Loitering

Profanity
