Club Newsletter Award

County Club Council has established a Club Newsletter Award to be given at Achievement Night each 4-H year. A gold, blue or red award will be given to club editors using the Danish system of judging. Twenty five dollars (\$25.00) will be given to the club with the most outstanding newsletter.

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Submit by the deadline established by the County Club Council each year seven issues for competition if less are published submit the number published. Please DO NOT submit originals or paste-ups; only submit issue copies as mailed or given out to club members and leaders. If you email your newsletter print a copy of the email version. If your newsletter is in color please submit color issues for competition. NOTE: Late books will not be accepted for judging.
- 2. At the time each issue is published, you may submit a copy to the 4-H office.
- 3. An adult may do the typing of the newsletter, but a 4-H member must do the editing and layout.
- 4. Submit issue copies in a three-ring binder along with the signed *Newsletter Award Information Sheet* as the cover page for judging. This form must be completed and signed by all Editor(s) and the Club Leader for your book to be included in the competition.
- 5. All newsletters will be judged equally, regardless of access to technology.
