



SA COMMUNITY FOOTBALL LEAGUE

2015/16 GUIDELINES AND APPLICATION FORM

The Clubs SA community football facility fund provides grants up to \$5,000 to community football clubs for minor facility upgrades and maintenance.

Overview: To provide subsidy grants to community sporting Clubs that share common facilities

(mainly football, netball and/or cricket) for facility upgrades and improvements.

Objective: To improve facilities and provide increased opportunities to grow participation and

involvement within the community in your Club.

Grants: Up to \$2 in \$4

\$5,000 for \$10,000 projects (up to a maximum grant of \$5,000)

Funding Round: 1st November 2015 - 31st of October 2016

Eligible Projects: Improvements or upgrades to:

1) Changerooms, showers, umpires rooms, time keeper/coaches boxes and media areas etc.

2) Oval lighting.

3) Patron facilities (ie: scoreboard, grandstand, shelters etc.)

4) New goal posts purchased from SACFL- preferred supplier PILA Group.

 Development or upgrade to any fixed facility that supports the delivery of football

Eligibility Criteria:

- 1. Compliant with all terms of affiliation
- 2. Funding will be released on completion of project
- 3. One successful application per club can be submitted each year
- **4.** Compliance with all acquittal requirements:
 - Submit written notice including photo evidence to the SACFL confirming project completion
 - Submit a letter addressed to Club SA acknowledging their contribution to the project (letter template to be provided by SA Community Football)
 - Attach all photos, media and promotional materials relevant to the project
 - Sign acknowledging contribution from SACFL and Clubs SA to be displayed on wall in social club
 for three years from date of approval of grant or completion (sign to be provided by SA
 Community Football).
 - Achieve SWISSE AFL Community Club Improvement Program status
