How to Apply for Equipment

SNIP International will consider applications for specialist equipment to use in trap/catch-neuter-return programmes.



- 1. All applications for equipment must be on the SNIP International application form, and either sent to us by e-mail (preferred method), or by post with a letter
- 2. Application forms should contain as much information as possible and all parts of the application form must be completed.
 - <u>The basic recommended kit for cats</u> is a trap and transfer restrainer. We are also happy to consider donating baskets and trap combs.
 - <u>The recommended equipment for dogs is gloves and traps.</u> We can consider donating alternative forms of equipment if the group can show evidence that they have had <u>approved</u> training.
- 3. SNIP International will consider applications to the value of £200 including VAT which in the UK is currently +20%; in exceptional cases this sum can be exceeded. The cost of equipment can be found in the MDC Exports catalogue on their web site (www.mdcexports.co.uk). Please note that the cost of equipment shown in their catalogue does *not* include UK Value Added Tax or delivery costs. This means you *must add 20%* to the costs given in the catalogue.
- 4. Wherever possible groups should give a UK delivery address. They should then arrange for transport to the final destination from that UK address. Where this is not possible applicants may be asked to contribute to delivery costs. Applicants will be asked to agree these costs before the equipment is sent.
- 5. All applications will be acknowledged, but this may take some time, particularly if the application is sent by ordinary mail.
- 6. All applications will be discussed by the Board of Trustees at their meetings, which are held approximately every three months. This means it may be up to three months before an application is considered. We will tell you the decision of the Board of Trustees as soon as we can.
- 7. A condition of any grant is that a report is submitted to SNIP International within 6 months of the equipment being delivered. This report should briefly tell us how the equipment has been used and anything else you think is important or interesting. Ideally the report should use photographs to demonstrate the equipment in use. If no report is forthcoming it is unlikely that any further request will be considered.

Any part of the report and any photographs may be used on the SNIP International web site, Facebook page, our newsletters and leaflets, and in reports to members. **Please let us know if for any reason you do not wish us to use all or part of your report.** If a successful applicant group has a web site a reciprocal link between their site and SNIP International's web site would be welcomed and to 'Like' SNIP International's Facebook page.

NB Only one application from a group will be considered in any 12 month period.
