## PRIVACY ACT STATEMENT

In accordance with the Privacy Act of 1974 (Public Law 93-579), this notice informs you of the purpose for collection of information on this form. Please read it before completing the form.

<u>Authority</u>: Title 10 U.S.C. Section 8013, Privacy Act System Notice F044 AF SG U, Special Needs and Educational and Developmental Intervention Services(EDIS), and AFI 33-332, Privacy Act Program, Exceptional Family Member Program (EFMP).

<u>**Principal Purpose</u>**: Information provided will be used by personnel of the Department of Defense (DoD) to assess eligibility for and manage installation-level EFMP activities and services.</u>

**<u>Retention and Safeguards</u>**: Paper and electronic records are restricted to authorized personnel with an official need-to-know. Electronic data is maintained in a password restricted case management system and encrypted while at rest and during transmission. Physical access for all records are controlled by locked terminals and rooms, guards, personnel screening, or visitor registers.

**<u>Routine Uses</u>**: In addition to those disclosures generally permitted under <u>5 U.S.C. 552a</u>(b) of the Privacy Act of 1974, these records may be disclosed outside DoD as a routine use pursuant to the DoD Blanket Routine Uses that appear at <u>http://privacy.defense.gov/notices/</u> <u>blanket\_uses.shtml</u>.
