#### SOLEMNITY OF THE BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST

Jesus has gifted us with Himself. At Mass we sit at the table of the Word and He feeds our memories

with the life of God and the self-giving of Jesus. Then we move to the table of Eucharist where He gives His body and blood to our body and blood.

Occasionally, when St. Augustine was giving Eucharist to a communicant instead of saying "Body of Christ," he would say "Receive what you are." He was reminding the communicant that we become the body and blood of Christ. Like the bread and wine we are meant to be changed/transformed.

This sacrament is the way we join in the physical life of Christ. His body becomes one with our bodies in an intimate transformation. We are fed to be sent out into the physical/spiritual world to be Christ to it.

## FEAST OF THE SACRED HEART

On Friday, June 7, we celebrate the Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. This feast is a reminder to all of us of the importance of our belief that the God of Jesus is the God of infinite love. It's a reminder to us also that God loves each one of us personally and individually. Consider celebrating the Eucharist on this day in thanksgiving for the gift of His love. The Masses are at 6:30 AM and 8:30 AM.
