Registration Information

We will be holding a Registration Day on Saturday 21 February 2015 at Mooroolbark Baptist Church, Hull Road, Mooroolbark from 10am - 12.30pm (free BBQ). We encourage you all to come along and get to know members of our soccer community. Club clothing will be on sale at competitive prices.

The Club and Association Registration Forms (for MBSC and the VCFA) must be completed in full and accompanied by payment to enable us to register each player in the VCFA. Forms can be downloaded from www.mooroolbarkknights.com An MBSC and a VCFA form per player is required.

Full payment is required by Wednesday, 11 March. If payment is not received by this date the player will not be eligible to play any games until the money is received. If you are having financial difficulties then please don't hesitate to contact our Treasurer so we can arrange a payment plan.

Our club is a not-for-profit club and as such our fees are the lowest that we can possibly do.

Your fees pay for the following;

- VCFA Fees (registering teams and players)
- Equipment (Balls, Goal Nets, Line Marking Equipment etc)
- Uniforms (Shirts but NOT shorts@\$30 or socks @\$15 per pair – available on Registration Day)
- Ground hire
- Payment of Referees
- · Other costs that come along the way

Players are encouraged to take up their own personal accident insurance.

Teams

Final decisions on 2015 teams will be based on registrations received. Last year the teams we fielded were:

Senior Men's:

Knights (Premier League), Warriors (Div 3), Vikings (Div 6).

Senior Ladies: Raiders (Div 1), Amazons (Div 2). Juniors: Falcons (U17), Condors (U15), Sharks (U13), Burra's (U11).

This season we will launch an exciting new junior level initiative – **Goal Kick**. These non-cometitive skill-training and games will run on Saturday mornings at 11am and will be for 3-6 year olds. Goal Kick will run when the rest of the junior teams are playing at home

We also plan to start a new U8/9 team.

Training

Training is held at Morrison Reserve (Pembroke High School entrance) in Mt Evelyn. Each team will train Wednesdays (Juniors 5:30-6:30pm and Seniors arrive at 6:30-8:00pm) once a week throughout the year (no Junior training during school holidays). If you are unable to attend training please let your coach know before the night. Team selections will be based upon training attendances.

Training for Senior Mens, Ladies commences **Wednesday 18th February**.

Training for all other Junior teams commences with a bring a friend free sausage sizzle with prizes on **Wednesday 25th February.**

Until April 5th formal training and preseason training will remain at Yarra Ranges Secondary School, Reah Rd, Mooroolbark.

Check the website for pre-season training dates in January and February.

Uniform

The club provides each registered player with a club shirt for the season. Shirts will be presented at training to players in the week of their first game.

Personalised shirts for junior players can be purchased through the club for \$45. See the Registration Desk regarding NAME and NUMBER. Note: number preferences are given to longest serving players.

It is the player's responsibility to get the following items to complete the uniform:

- MBSC red shorts (compulsory @\$30 or supplied free if registering and paying on registration day)
- shin pads and soccer boots
- MBSC Socks (compulsory @ \$15 per pair)

All club wear will be available for purchase on Registration Day and training nights.

We also have alternate strips of white top, red shorts and socks, and a blue top, shorts and socks. The Club will provide teams with an alternate strip in the rare occasion they're needed.

Fundraising

This year our club will be holding various fundraisers to help with the financial costs of the club. Details will be provided throughout the year.
