## Special Olympics 2014 USA Games in New Jersey

Every four years Special Olympics conducts a National Summer Games in the United States that includes athletes from all 50 US Programs. New Jersey is proud to have been selected as host of the 2014 Special Olympics USA Games, the Games of Welcome and Acceptance. The 2014 Special Olympics USA Games will showcase athletes competing in 14 official and 3 demonstration sports during the week of June 14 - 21. Competitions will be offered in both Traditional and Unified play, bringing together the community to support and play side-by-side with our athletes, in what expects to be the most inclusive Games in Special Olympics History.

## SPECIAL OLYMPIC BOWLING INFORMATION

### Registration

1. Please submit the registration form that you receive from your local bowling program to the Recreation Office
2. You will receive a confirmation card stating that we have received your registration form and that you have an up to date Special Olympics Medical Form on file
3. Once we receive all the information on competition dates from Special Olympics, you will receive a letter in the mail with dates and times of competition events.
4. You will need to get a new medical form if you received your medical form in the year 2010 or before.

### Requirements:

For an individual to be eligible to participate in a Special Olympics Training Program or Competition, the following guidelines must be met:

- All athletes must have a current Special Olympics Medical Form on file with The Arc Recreation Department and must have bowled 15 games to be eligible by December 7, 2012!

All athletes must have a 15 game minimum submitted to The Arc Recreation Department and an updated medical form on file.

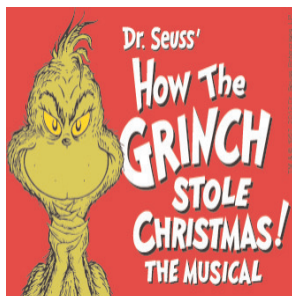

### Registration

### Cancellation

If fewer than the minimum participants register for a program, it may be cancelled. A program reimbursement or credit slip will be issued. Refunds are not guaranteed for any program. If the individual cancels for a program, he or she must give at least three (3) days notice for a refund. Please note that in the event of a cancellation, we may not be able to refund your money.

### Office Hours

The Recreation Department office hours are 9:00 am - 4:30 pm, Monday through Friday. The office phone number is 732-493-0225.

### Change of Address or Phone

If you have moved or changed your phone number, please let us know. It is important that the Recreation office records are kept up-to-date in order to provide you with the best possible service.

### Inclement Weather

In the event of poor or questionable weather, call our office for updated information. Our number is 732-493-0225. When the program is cancelled, a message will be left no earlier than 1 1/2 hours prior to the activity. If the agency is closed due to bad weather, all programs will be cancelled.
