SPECIAL OLYMPIC BOWLING INFORMATION

Registration

- 1. Please submit the registration form that you receive from your local bowling program to the Recreation Office
- 2. You will receive a confirmation card stating that we have received your registration form and that you have an up to date Special Olympics Medical Form on file
- 3. Once we receive all the information on competition dates from Special Olympics, you will receive a letter in the mail with dates and times of competition events.
- 4. You will need to get a new medical form if you received your medical form in the year 2010 or before.

Requirements:

For an individual to be eligible to participate in a Special Olympics Training Program or Competition, the following guidelines must be met:

- All athletes must have a current Special Olympics Medical Form on file with The Arc Recreation Department and must have bowled 15 games to be eligible by December 7, 2012!




23rd Annual Festival of Trees

If the individual cancels for a program, he or she must give at least three (3) days notice for a refund. Please note that in the event of a cancellation, we may not be able to refund your money.
