“RISE TO THE CHALLENGE”

“Rise to the Challenge” is something we all strive to do everyday of our lives. It’s true, that some days are tougher than others, but as Christians, we are so blessed to have a loving

Father in heaven that helps us along the way. He certainly has helped Crowley’s Ridge College along the way. He’s blessed us with the very students that we are privileged to serve and He’s blessed us with numerous supporters that care about our mission of promoting academic and spiritual growth in every student enrolled at CRC.

We are glad to tell you that we’ve managed our resources well. Over the last 13 years, CRC has had an average surplus of \$156,000 per year. We strongly believe this surplus of funds has been used wisely by increasing our academic offerings from 3 degrees to 11 degrees and we’ve used part of the surplus on building two new facilities; the Student Center and the Johnson Honor Housing I apartment complex. Plus, we’ve improved

the Wilson and Winters Halls, the Jennie Sue Eubanks Cafeteria, Carter Activities Center, Larry M. Bills Administration building, campus roads and parking areas, many technology areas and other needs.

We’re excited that 226 students are enrolled at CRC this fall semester, which is **another record enrollment!** With such strong enrollment numbers, we are convinced that now is time to again add more on-campus student housing. In July, our board of trustees approved the building of a new student housing facility to help address CRC’s increased enrollment numbers. The new facility, Honor Housing II, will again be an apartment style complex. This will be a 14 bed unit, similar to the Joe A. and Wanda Hall Johnson Honor Housing built in 2012. It is critical that we build this Honor Housing II apartment complex and have it ready for our students by the fall semester of 2016. We will start immediately on this new student housing facility and we are asking for your help with a challenge gift opportunity to help pay for this apartment complex.

This Honor Housing II apartment complex will cost an estimated \$250,000.

Our goal is to raise \$100,000 by June 30, 2016. Meeting this goal can put CRC in a position to qualify for a \$150,000 challenge grant gift, which is 60% of the \$250,000 needed to completely pay for this new student housing facility. Before we can ask for this \$150,000 challenge grant gift, we first must provide proof that we have commitments in place for \$100,000, which is 40% of the total funds needed. This is a fairly standard practice in working with challenge grants. The challenge is given to nonprofits such as CRC to prove we have friends who believe in our mission and will help us pay for a new facility. Meeting this challenge tells the grant gift provider that CRC also has the ability to raise funds, that we can fund future expenses and that we are not fully relying on the challenge gift provider to completely fund the new facility.

Can we rise to the challenge? Of course we can! We have met the challenge before when we built the new Student Center in 2010 and again in 2012 with the building of the Joe A. and Wanda Hall Johnson Honor Housing. We received a \$63,000 challenge gift for the Student Center and nearly 130 gifts were received in helping pay for the Johnson Honor Housing. **Please use the Honor Housing II coupon on the right** and send your gift today.
