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North Carolina State Bar 2013 Application for Certification as a Specialist

1. **Standards** - Read the North Carolina Plan of Specialization and the standards for certification in your specialty area. These materials are found at 27 N.C.A.C. 1D, Sect. 1700 *et seq.* and are published in the North Carolina State Bar *Lawyer's Handbook* and on our website: www.ncbar.gov.
2. **Fees** - A filing fee of \$250 must accompany this application. All checks should be payable to North Carolina State Bar Board of Legal Specialization. Rejection or withdrawal of an application will not entitle an applicant to a refund of the fee or any part of the fee. **Applications postmarked by June 14, 2013, will qualify for a \$50 discount on the application fee.** The exam fee of \$150 will be due and payable upon notification that an applicant is eligible to take a specialty examination.
3. **Filing Timeliness** - The application shall be considered timely filed if the application is delivered to the office of the North Carolina State Bar before 5:00 p.m. on July 1, 2013, or is postmarked no later than July 1, 2013.
4. **INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING APPLICATION FORM**
 - A. **PLEASE ANSWER EACH QUESTION.** If additional space is needed to answer a question, please attach pages to the application.
 - B. **REFERENCES** - Each applicant for certification is asked to submit the names and addresses of 10 references in support of his or her application. It is preferred that references have experience in the applicable specialty. The extent of a reference's involvement in the applicable specialty and relationship to the applicant will be considered in the evaluation process. All of references will be contacted by the Board Legal Specialization, or its representatives, and asked to complete written peer reference statements. A minimum of 5 complete peer reference statements must be received in order for an application to advance. The applicant is not responsible for asking the listed references to complete the forms. The Board, or its representatives, may contact, in person or by telephone, any reference listed by an applicant or any other lawyer or judge qualified to evaluate the applicant's competence and qualification in the specialty area.
5. **Processing of Applications** - Only completed applications will be reviewed by the Board of Legal Specialization. Each applicant will be notified by mail as to whether his or her application is complete.
6. **Examination** - A notice with the time and location of the examination will be sent to you when it is determined you are eligible to take the exam.
7. **Confidentiality** - All information contained in the application, supporting documents, peer reference information and statements, and examination results are confidential unless subject to the North Carolina Public Records Act. They shall be available for use only by the Board, the appropriate specialty committee, or any appropriate body or tribunal in the event of an appeal.
8. **Special Testing Accommodations for Disabled Applicants** - A written request for special accommodations, supported by documentation of disability, must be submitted to the executive director at least 30 days prior to sitting for the exam.
