LSU's Ronald E. McNair Research Scholars program promotes a new cohort of scholars that more accurately reflects the emergent diversity in life experiences, cultures and perspectives represented in academia by preparing students who are first-generation and low-income or ethnically underrepresented in graduate education for doctoral studies. We connect undergraduate students with faculty-directed research experiences, provide individualized advisement, and foster knowledge of the graduate school application process. Funded by a federal grant from the US Department of Education TRIO programs, McNair Research Scholars conduct research under the mentorship of some of the most distinguished faculty in the country and communicate the results of their work through publications and workshops.

STATEMENT OF PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY

The LSU McNair Research Scholars Program is a federally funded TRIO program designed to enhance the educational success of:

Full-time LSU students whose parents do not have four-year college degrees and have a financial need in funding their education (financial need is determined by taxable income and typically aligns with Pell Grant eligibility)

AND

Students who identify with an ethnic heritage typically underrepresented in graduate education $% \left(1\right) =\left(1\right) \left(1\right)$

All students are welcome to apply, but selections will consider students who meet either criteria described above.

RESIDENCY CRITERIA

A student is eligible to participate in a McNair project if the student meets all the following requirements:

- (1) Is a citizen or national of the United States; or
- (2) Is a permanent resident of the United States; or
- (3) Is in the United States for other than a temporary purpose and provides evidence from the Immigration and Naturalization Service of his or her intent to become a permanent resident; or
- (4) Is a permanent resident of Guam, the Northern Mariana Islands, or the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands; or
- (5) Is a resident of one of the Freely Associated States.
