- 1. One (1) contestant from each school may compete.
- TIME LIMIT: (2) two minutes of time is allotted. The contestant will be given his/her topic at the start of the (2) minutes. The contestant must speak for a minimum of one minute. Five points will be deducted from the speaker's score for every 15 seconds that the time deviates <u>over</u> or <u>under</u> the limit.
- 3. An official timekeeper will record times. A maximum of (1) one minute, which is part of the two-minute limit, may be used for the student to get his/her ideas together. An official timekeeper will record scores.
- 4. The speech must be original. No paper, note cards, props, costumes or pre-written speeches will be allowed.
- 5. ONLY contestants report to the contest area at the designated time for the competition.
