Manager of Landfill Operations (MOLO):

To provide professionals involved in the management of MSW landfills with the basic information to run a successful operation.

Course Content:

This 3-day course consists of presentations by SWANA certified landfill instructors, classroom exercises, case studies, and a half-day tour and field exercise at a local landfill. Please bring a calculator for class activities.

Upon Completion of this Course Participants Will:

- Understand the issues to be considered when planning, operating, and closing a landfill, including landfill economics.
- Learn the basics of landfill site restrictions, how to comply with design requirements, bioreactor landfills, leachate and landfill gas management.
- Know about compliance inspections, basic regulatory standards, and the importance of safety and contingency plans.
- Prepare for SWANA's MOLO certification exam.

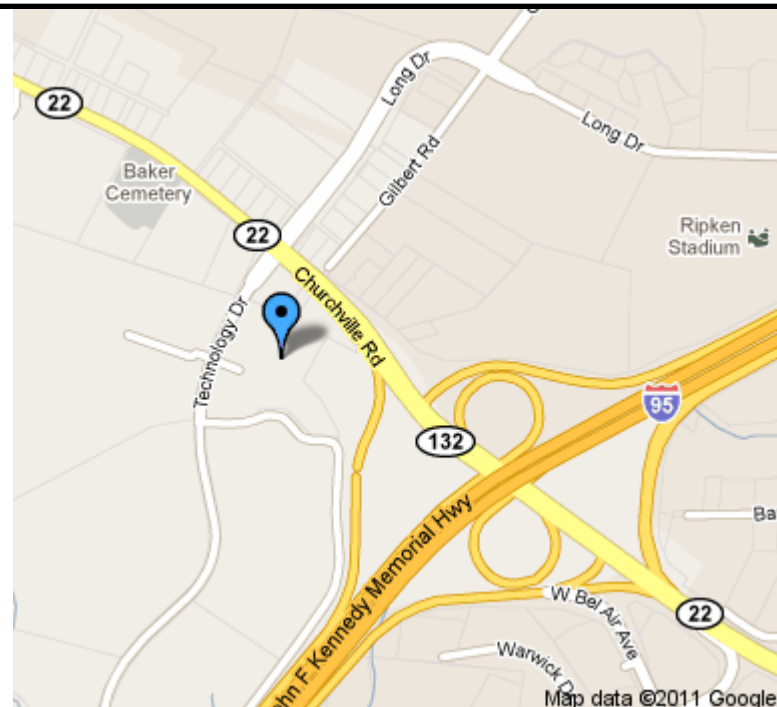

Pete Bieniek

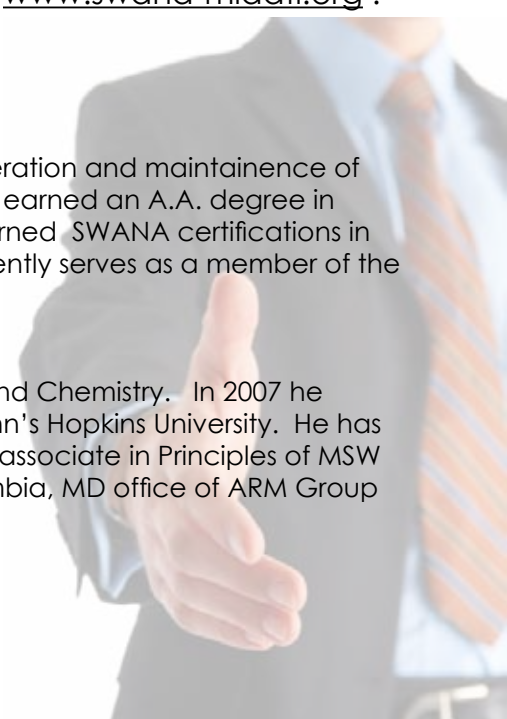
