# POSITION DESCRIPTION

Under the direction of the Executive Officer, Chief Athletic Inspector, or Assistant Chief Athletic Inspector of the State Athletic Commission, to do work involved in enforcing the State laws and rules of the State Athletic Commission regulating boxing, kickboxing, and martial arts; and to do other related work.

Positions exist statewide.

#### REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMITTANCE TO THE EXAMINATION

All applicants must meet the education and/or experience requirements for this examination on the date that they complete and submit their application and supplemental application to the above address.

Qualifying experience may be combined on a proportionate basis if the requirements stated below include more than one pattern and are distinguished as "Either" I, "or" II, etc. For example, candidate's possessing qualifying experience amounting to 50% of the required time of Pattern I, and additional experience amounting to 50% of the required time of Pattern II, may be admitted to an examination as meeting 100% of the overall experience requirement.

#### MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Paid employment in boxing, kickboxing, or full-contact martial arts sports in several matches or exhibitions as an official, participant, manager, club owner, matchmaker, trainer, box-office employee, or as a news media reporter reporting boxing, kickboxing, or full-contact martial arts matches.

Two years of experience and involvement in the fields of boxing, kickboxing, or full-contact martial arts, or experience and involvement in the collection of State revenue assessment and of State taxes.

# **EXAMINATION INFORMATION**

#### **Supplemental Application -- Weighted 100.00%**

This examination will consist of a supplemental application weighted 100%. To obtain a position on the eligible list, applicants must achieve a minimum rating of 70% on the supplemental application.

Candidates must complete the supplemental application which is designed to elicit a range of specific information regarding each candidate's knowledge, abilities, and potential to effectively perform the duties relative to the classification. **RETURN OF THE SUPPLEMENTAL APPLICATION IS MANDATORY.** Candidates who do not return the completed application (Std. 678) and the supplemental application will be eliminated from this examination.

#### **EXAM SCOPE**

#### Knowledge of:

- State law and rules of the State Athletic Commission regulating boxing, kickboxing, and fullcontact martial arts matches.
- 2. Procedure, equipment, and terminology of boxing, kickboxing, and full-contact martial arts sports in California.
- Methods used in attempting to evade the laws and rules regulating licensed boxing, kickboxing, and full-contact martial arts.
- 4. General knowledge of State operations dealing with collection of revenue, calculations of budgets, and assessment of State taxes.

#### Ability to:

- Read and write English at a level required for successful job performance.
- 2. Interpret and apply the State law and the rules of the State Athletic Commission regulating boxing, kickboxing, and full-contact martial arts and detect evasions.
- 3. Make attendance estimates, compute ticket sales, and prepare simple financial reports.
- 4. Write concise but comprehensive reports.
- 5. Maintain cooperative relations with persons contacted in the course of the work.
- 6. Analyze situations accurately and adopt an effective course of action.
- 7. Follow oral and written directions.

Keenness of observation and tact.

Education equivalent to completion of the twelfth grade.

# ELIGIBLE LIST INFORMATION

An Open Statewide eligible list will be established for the Department of Consumer Affairs. The list will be abolished 12 months after it is established unless the needs of the service and conditions of the list warrant a change.

#### VETERANS PREFERENCE CREDITS

Veteran's preference will be added to the final score of those competitors who are successful in this examination and who qualify for and have requested these points THROUGH California Department of Human Resources (CalHR). Veterans who have achieved permanent civil service status are not eligible to receive veteran's credits.

#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

The Department of Consumer Affairs reserves the right to revise the examination plan to better meet the needs of the service if the circumstances under which this examination was planned change. Such revision will be in accordance with civil service laws and rules and all competitors will be notified.

**If you meet the requirements stated** on this bulletin, you may take this examination. Possession of the entrance requirement does not assure a place on the eligible list. Your performance in the examination described on this bulletin will be compared against predetermined rating criteria. All candidates who pass will be ranked according to their scores.

**Employment lists:** Employment lists are established by competitive examination and are used in the following order, regardless of list date: 1) sub divisional promotional, 2) departmental promotional, 3) multi-departmental promotional, 4) service wide promotional, 5) departmental open, and 6) open. The oldest dated list will be used first. All lists will expire in one to four years unless otherwise stated on this bulletin.

**Veterans' Preference:** Effective January 1, 2014, in accordance with Government Code 18973.1 and 18973.5, Veterans' Preference will be awarded as follows: 1.) Any veteran, widow or widower of a veteran, or spouse of a 100 percent disabled veteran, who achieves a passing score in an entrance examination, shall be ranked in the top rank of the resulting eligibility list. Any veteran who has been dishonorably discharged or released is not eligible for Veterans' Preference. 2.) An entrance examination is defined, under the law, as any open competitive examination. And 3.) Veterans' Preference is not granted once a person achieves permanent civil service status. Veteran status is verified by the California Department of Human Resources (CalHR). Directions to apply for Veterans' Preference are on the Veterans' Preference Application (Std. Form 1093), which is available at http://jobs.ca.gov/Job/Veteransinformation, and the Department of Veterans Affairs.

**General Qualifications:** Candidates must possess essential personal qualifications including integrity, initiative, dependability, good judgment, and ability to work cooperatively with others. Competitors must be in a state of health consistent with the ability to perform the essential functions of the duties assigned to the class. A medical examination may be required. In open examinations, investigation of employment records, personal history, and fingerprinting may be required.
