For those families who have already filed, please be sure to check the application status for incomplete applications or any documents that are still needed. Financial aid will not be awarded to families who do not file by the deadline date or have incomplete applications! Families who need help filing or do not have a computer may contact the school office at 918.627.5367.
- St. Pius X Support-A-Student Financial Aid may be accessed online through the FACTS tuition aid website. Parents are also required to complete the FACTS Grant Aid and Assessment form in order to be eligible for Support-A-Student. St. Pius X Support-A-

Student is **only** a vailable for St. Pius X Church parishioners.
