SHOW INFORMATION

This is a Rain or Shine event to be held at Rosedale Park at 340 Dartmouth at N. General McMullen Dr. All brands of motorcycles and cars are welcome. Participants should insure that lights, signals, brakes, clutch, throttle, and horn are operational. Tires should be in decent condition (good tread, no cupping or cracking). All motorcycles and cars must be complete and be able to start. Vehicles will be showcased with like vehicles. Each car will receive two standard parking lot spaces. Bikes will receive one standard parking lot space with a buffer parking space between the next participants. Show Awards shall be based by popular vote with each voter receiving one ballot only.

CAR CLASSIFICATIONS (select one)

- Classic Stock:** Any car that is manufactured in or prior to 1963 that has not been modified and is in stock condition using only new parts to keep the car running. Basic cosmetic changes (i.e. wheels, stereo, engine dress-up kits, etc.) can be considered for the "stock class".
- Hot Rod:** Any car that is manufactured in or prior to 1963 that has been customized. Suspension, brakes, steering, non-original paint schemes and body modifications will be considered a custom car.
- Muscle Stock:** Any car that is manufactured in 1964 or later that has not been modified and is in stock condition using only new parts to keep the car running. Basic cosmetic changes (i.e. wheels, stereo, engine dress-up kits, etc.) can be considered for the "stock class".
- Street Rod:** Any car that is manufactured in 1964 or later that has been customized. Suspension, brakes, steering, non-original paint schemes and body modifications will be considered a custom car.

MOTORCYCLE CLASSIFICATIONS (select one)

- Cruiser:** Any motorcycle that is used for touring or cruising.
- Custom:** Any fully or partially customized motorcycle. This includes a built from scratch (OCC) or chopper.
- Antique/Classic:** Any motorcycle that is 25 YEARS OR OLDER in stock condition, or with new parts only to keep the motorcycle running (not custom parts).
- Sport Bike:** Any make/model motorcycle originally manufactured for high performance with a lightweight frame.
- Trike & Others:** Any three-wheeled other bike classification that doesn't meet the above.
