**Directions: Choose three activities to complete for your book report. Your choices must be in a horizontal, vertical, or diagonal Tic-Tac-Toe line.**

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Collage</b></p> <p>Use magazines, newspapers, or other appropriate sources to make a collage of pictures about your book. Check with your parents before cutting up magazines or newspapers!</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Sandwich</b></p> <p>Make a book report sandwich out of paper. The sandwich will contain the main elements of the book. Ex. Top Slice of Bread: Characters Cheese: Setting Tomatoes: Conflicts Turkey: Turning Point Bottom Slice: Resolution <a href="http://www.scholastic.com/kids/homework/sandwich.asp">http://www.scholastic.com/kids/homework/sandwich.asp</a></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Time Line</b></p> <p>Make a time line of at least ten events in your story. You may not have years or times to put on your time line. However, you should put the events in the correct order. Decorate your time line.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Cartoon</b></p> <p>Make a cartoon about your book. You may use your computer to help you. However, the cartoon should not be on disk. You should print the cartoon, or you may draw the cartoon by hand. Use color!</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Plot Chart</b></p> <p>Make a plot chart of your book. Include the exposition, rising actions, climax, falling actions, resolution, and conflicts of your book. Decorate the chart to make it colorful and creative.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Art</b></p> <p>Draw a colorful picture or scene that relates to your book. Do not copy and paste a picture from the internet.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Book Report Recipe</b></p> <p>Write a recipe for your book report. Example: One cup of plot (include a brief statement of plot). ½ cup of setting (include the setting) A sprinkling of characters (list the characters here) Stir the ingredients together and enjoy!</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Book Cover</b></p> <p>Design a book cover for your book. Make it colorful. The book cover should represent something important about the book.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Word Wall Mini</b></p> <p>Make a word wall on paper of at least ten words that are found in your book. Include the definition for each word on your word wall. Decorate the wall. Try to give your wall a fun theme (leaves on a tree, bricks in a wall, petals on a flower, etc.). You could choose a theme that relates to your book!</p>

## Tic-Tac-Toe Book Report

1. Choose a fiction or a non-fiction book that you have not read before and has not been a movie.
2. The book should be at least 100 pages in length.
3. Choose three activities in a vertical, horizontal, or diagonal line from the Tic-Tac-Toe board.
4. You will present these three activities on the due date shown at the bottom of this page.
5. You may use one sheet of poster board to complete all three activities. Just divide the poster into three sections.
6. Do not use notebook paper or small sheets of paper to display your project. Your project should be neat, colorful, and easy-to-see from the audience.
7. The general rubric below will be used for each part of your project. Your grade will be the average of the three parts.
8. Late work will receive 10% off (per day) the grade earned. If you are absent on the day of the book report, this does not count against you. You should be prepared to present on the next available day, or you will receive 10% off a day.
9. It is not necessary that you purchase many things for this project. Most of the projects can be completed with poster board and markers.
