- Playing games
- Visiting the school library
- Reading together
- Computer activities
- Classroom parties / special activities

Opportunities are also available if you would like to volunteer in the school as a lunch buddy, homework helper, or science lab assistant.

When and Where?

Mentors are asked to visit the school and spend at least 20 minutes twice a month with their student.

Mentors who would like to visit their student outside of school hours will need to make arrangements with the child's parent or guardian.

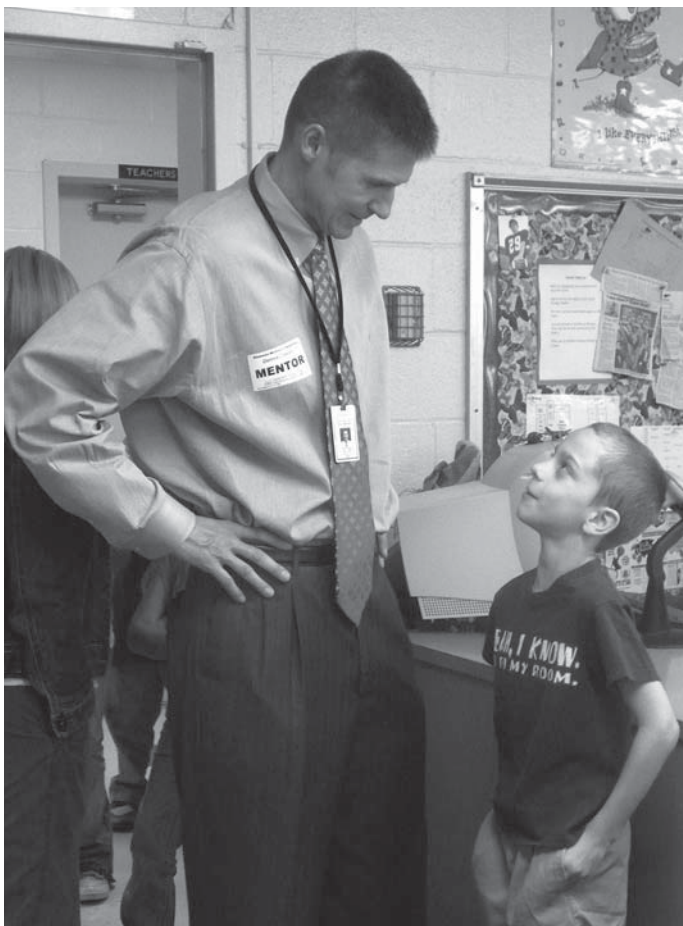
