BrumVenture is back for another exciting year at Pike's Pool, one of Birmingham's premier Scouting Centres. Over the course of the weekend, each Scout that applies will take part in one of twelve different activity badge course. These include the Angler, Chef, Craft, Cyclist, DIY, (Master-at-Arms) Archery, Forester, Mechanic, Pioneer, Radio Communicator, (Master-at-arms) Rifles, Photographer badges & new for 2016, Emergency Aid stage 4 badge.














By the end of the weekend, not only will Scouts have had the opportunity to gain the activity badge, but also will be among the few to earn the much sought after 'BrumVenture Award'.

The cost for the weekend will be £45.00 (non refundable), which includes camp fees, food, activities and both badges for their uniform.

Before the weekend, Scouts must be able to attend the **BrumVenture 'Big Launch' on Wednesday 7th September**. There are limited places available for BrumVenture, so to avoid disappointment, please return the completed form along with £45.00 payment. The closing date for applications (including payment) is Friday 22nd July 2016 (or first 120 applications).

Badge allocations will be selected at random on or after 15th April 2016 with an independant adjudicator.

This is a Scout Section activity and only Scouts under the age of 14 years old on 7th October 2016 can attend the event. The badge courses which will be run over the weekend are as follows. Please indicate overleaf which badge course you would prefer to attend by ranking each badge from 1 to 13 (1 being your first choice and 13 your last). If you already have one of the badges please indicate this with a X in the space provided
All activities will be properly supervised by appropriately qualified personnel, according to Scout Association policy and rules.

	Angler – You'll need to be 12 years old on 07/10/16 and have fished on at least 1 previous occasion.		Chef – you will be under the tuition of 'Chef' and their team, learning to plan and serve a full menu under camp conditions.
	Communicator – you'll learn the basics of radio communication using amateur frequency bands. Also means drinking lots of tea..		Craft – Undertake a minimum of a six hour project to make or decorate an item as agreed with the team using agreed materials
	Cyclist – Use a bicycle that is properly equipped and kept in good working order, carry out essential maintenance and show good control		D.I.Y – you'll be taught the basics of home D.I.Y emergencies and carry out a small maintenance project
	Emergency Aid – Stage 4 You will be trained in many aspects of first aid including how you help someone who is unconscious, unconscious and not breathing. bleeds, burns, breaks, heat exhaustion & hypothermia		Foresters – you'll be learning the correct use of knives and axes, while being involved in actual tree and woodland management.
	Mechanic – you'll learn aspects of vehicle maintenance, from checking the oil to changing the tyre		Master at Arms 1 – you'll be taught the target discipline of archery.
	Photographer - You'll look at all aspects of photography from taking pictures, editing and printing as well as documenting the weekend		Master at Arms 2 – you'll be taught the target discipline of air rifles. You MUST be at least 12½ on 07/10/16
			Pioneering – you'll learn to build projects such as Runways, Catapults and Watch Towers. The course will finish with the group completing some of these projects on a large scale.
