Code of Conduct:

Consequences for violation of the Code of Conduct will be loss of recess, removal from classroom, suspension, and/or expulsion from VCS Summer Fun program.

- 1. Students, who use, write, distribute, or possess, indecent or obscene language, literature, writing, or pictures, shall be suspended from school. Students are expected to report vandalism.
- 2. Students are not permitted to use tobacco, alcohol, or illegal drugs.
- 3. Running in the halls is strictly prohibited for safety reasons.
- 4. Horseplay and loud noise will not be permissible in the school building, on the school grounds, or while riding in school vehicles.
- 5. Radios and electronic games, and all toys are not to be brought on campus unless authorized. These devices can be authorized to be used by Administration but they cannot be responsible for them. No internet use at anytime (i.e. NO Facebook, Twitter, Instagram or YouTube). Texting to immediate family members only and Victory approved games allowed only. Violating the rules can result in items being confiscated by staff and given to the program's main office. A \$10 charge will be given for the 1st violation and \$25 for each additional time. *It's best to leave them home*.
- 6. Students will not be allowed to roam the hallways by themselves; they must be with their group or a designated buddy.
- 7. Students are not allowed to fight verbally or physically.
- 8. Students must refrain from any public display of affection (i.e. kissing, holding hands, embracing, etc.)
- 9. Only Christian music is to be played on campus or on school vehicles.
- 10. Gambling, in any form, will not be tolerated on or off campus.
- 11. Cheating, lying, or stealing are not part of the program and will not be tolerated.
- 12. Scoffing, scorning, offensive slang, taunting, bullying, and put-downs or disrespectful remarks or behavior are not tolerated.
- 13. Involvement in witchcraft, the occult, or astrology, is not allowed.
- 14. Students are to remain in dress code until they are off campus.
- 15. The wearing of sunglasses and hats in the building is prohibited unless a designated day for this.
- 16. Earrings are not permitted on male students on campus. Earrings will be collected and returned at the end of the day.

Classroom Code of Conduct:

- 1. Show proper respect to counselors and students.
- 2. Obey those in authority
- 3. Wait to be acknowledged by a counselor by raising your hand.
- 4. The classroom must remain clean at all times, campers are required to participate in keeping the rooms clean.
- 5. Behave in ways that do not disrupt others.
- 6. Be responsible.

Discipline:

Victory Christian School believes that discipline must be ministered with love. Both discipline and learning go hand-in-hand to build character and to allow students to best develop into whole persons. It is expected that students attending Summer Fun will put forth effort to listen and obey the voice of their "inner man" (Spirit). If your child is sent to our office for a disciplinary reason you will receive communication either by phone or a note explaining the situation and the actions which may result:

- 1. Loss of play time
- 2. Removal from the activity/classroom
- 3. Challenge(s) brought to attention of VCS Summer Fun Director and/or VCS principal
- 4. Suspension from the program
- 5. Expulsion from the program
