#### Guidelines

-The applicant must be entering college in an ag related degree.

-The applicant must attend a post-secondary (trade school, community college, college or university) institution the immediate semester following high school graduation.

#### Rules

-Applicant must fill out application form

-The scholarship will be awarded at the start of the first semester of their freshmen year.

-After receiving verification that they have enrolled in a post-secondary school a check will be made out to the student and the school that is being attended.

#### -March 15 is the deadline for applications.

-Sincerity of the applicant to further their education and career in an ag related field.

-Applicants involvement in Vo Ag , FFA, 4-H and other ag related activities.

-Leadership and involvement in high school activities.

-Must have a cumulative grade average of 80%.
