

The Board candidate application & registration form must be completed by any member applying for a vacant 2016 MEA Board of Director seat. The information provided is used to develop election materials provided to MEA members/voters, and also to verify whether the individual meets the minimum qualifications to be a candidate for the Board as stated in Article IV, Section 13 and Article IV, Section 4 (e) of the MEA bylaws.

Open board seats include Susitna East and Susitna West (see map on reverse page). No at-large or other district candidates will be accepted.

Annual Meeting and Election are scheduled for Tuesday, April 26, 2016 at Raven Hall at the Alaska State Fairgrounds. Candidates are encouraged to attend and all will be provided the opportunity to provide a 5 minute statement to the membership.

Candidate application deadline is Friday, February 12 at 5:00 p.m. Applications must be received by MEA on or before that date during normal business hours (8am-5pm):



RESOLUTION NO. 1976

CODE OF ETHICS FOR DIRECTORS OF MATANUSKA ELECTRIC ASSOCIATION, INC.

Directors must:

- 1. Conduct the business affairs of the association in good faith and with honesty and Integrity.
- 2. Represent the interest of all.
- Keep confidential any and all information relating to discussions at its executive session including any and all materials, reports or correspondence unless compelled by legal process to disclose such information.
- 4. Abide by rules and regulations of the association (including but not limited to the association's articles of incorporation and bylaws.
- 5. Support Board decisions.
- 6. Disqualify themselves from participation in a decision that may have a financial affect upon personal interests.

The Association reserves the right to determine if a perceived violation of the code of ethics has been breached and may be addressed by remedies available by law including but not limited to adopting a resolution expressing disapproval of the conduct of the Board member and/or private or public reprimand by the Board.
