Clinic Philosophy

Player development will occur when technical ability, tactical understanding and physical fitness are trained in a positive, challenging and competitive environment. This clinic has been designed to teach each player how to fully reach his/her potential through a demanding week of functional training exercises that teach individual techniques and tactics. This clinic's objective is to develop players who will respond to the challenges of the game in a confident and creative manner. Each day small sided games will be played to challenge all players in a competitive environment. The small sided game method is used so that each player gets more touches on the ball. This method will enable players to have more time on the ball, to improve their field awareness, to help their decision making and to increase their ability to read the game and anticipate the play.

David is entering his fourth season as the Associate Head Men's Soccer coach at Emerson College. He is a graduate of Boston College and holds his USSF "B" coaching license and his NSCAA Advanced Diploma. He is currently the Sachems FC Executive Director of Soccer. He recently coached his G17 team to a 2009 Presidents Cup National Championship and a MAPLE Division 1 Championship. He is a 2009 United States Youth Soccer National Girl's Competitive Coach of the year Finalist. He was 2009 USYSA Region 1 Girl's Competitive Coach of the year. David is a Massachusetts Olympic Development Head Coach for the Boys 13 team.
