Guitar Club (Mondays)

Learn to play the guitar. This beginner guitar class is designed to teach students how to play the guitar in a fun and interactive way. Students will learn to identify and play the notes on the instrument as well as important music theory. Students will be taught how to build and play chords, play melodies and read standard musical notation. A guitar is required for class. We can assist parents who need to buy an instrument for the class.) Grades: 2nd-5th Boys and Girls Min: 5 Max 12 # of classes: 8 Fee: \$103

Young Artistes (Tuesday)

Marcel DuChamp, Claude Monet and Jackson Pollack were known for their eclectic style and experimentation with art. We will explore our artistic talents by experimenting with a variety of arts and crafts projects to include card making, jewelry making, sketching, and pointillism (painting with lots of little dots). If you enjoy making art and being creative, then this class is for you. Grades: 3rd - 5th (Boys and Girls) Min: 8, Max: 16 # of classes: 8 Fee: \$125 Dates: 9/25 to 11/20 (No class on 11/6)



Soccer (Friday)

The Kicks for Kids Soccer program was created as an after school class for kids aspiring to be better soccer players. It is geared to improve the individual ball skills and techniques of the participants in a fun, interactive environment. Grades: k-5th Boys and Girls Min: 10, Max: 30 # of classes: 8 Fee: \$99 Dates: 9/28 to 11/30 (No classes on 10/19 & 11/23)



Young Musicians (Friday)

This creative music program develops children's natural enthusiasm for music by increasing fine and gross motor skills in a fun and interesting way that fosters music appreciation and understanding. Students try guitars, percussion instruments, woodwinds (saxophone, clarinet), brass (trumpet, trombone), strings (violin), and more! They also learn basic music reading/writing & rhythm. Grades: k-3rd Boys and Girls Min: 5, Max: 12 # of classes: 8 Fee: \$110 Dates: 9/28 to 11/30 (No classes on 10/19 & 11/23)



Origami Club (Friday)

Origami club is designed to teach the students the basic technique of Origami art in a fun and easy way. Origami is a traditional Japanese folk art of paper folding, which started in the mid-1900s and has evolved into a modern art form. The goal of this art is to transform a flat sheet of paper into a finished sculpture through folding and sculpting techniques. Participants will learn to make several shapes during the course of the program. Note: regular paper will be provided to students. No previous experience is required. Cost: \$105 Minimum 6- Maximum 12 Grades: 2nd-5th

Violin (Friday)

The Violin Enrichment program has been created as an after school re-enforcement class for beginner Violin school players also for new players.
