

ACT vs. SAT Seminar with Mini Tests

Since the ACT originated in the Mid-West, families on the East Coast are not as familiar with the ACT as the SAT. However, It is important to note that colleges accept the SAT and ACT on equal standing – with many even accepting the ACT in lieu of the SAT I and Subject II tests. Many students are more successful on one of these college prep tests than the other because of the nature of each test. This program is designed to provide insight into which may be the stronger test for your child or provide exposure to the ACT encouraging the pursuit of both tests. Following class you are welcome to talk with the instructor and review individual results. 2-Day SAT Preparation Lab

Give your child an edge to SAT success. A major factor in achieving a high score on the SAT is to know how to take this particular test! The SAT is a test of reasoning, not content. We teach the most effective strategies (Day 1). The students practice applying the strategies by taking a full-length SAT (Day 2). This is a hands-on, practical lab highly effective for students anywhere in their SAT or PSAT preparation. You will receive the test results, diagnostic analysis, and recommendations through the mail or email within 3 weeks (unless expedited results are requested). Includes an appointment with a college preparation counselor to discuss the test results, and provide recommendations specific to your child. This program shows you and your child where s/he stands in the SAT prep process. Students should bring a brown bag lunch/snacks, drink, calculator, highlighter and two pencils to each session.


Walking the dog?

Ways to Register:

Walk-In: Monday-Friday, 8:30 am-4:30 pm (use drop slot before/after hours) at the Doylestown Township Administrative Office, located at 425 Wells Road, Doylestown, PA 18901.

Payment: Credit card, cash, check or money order. Unless otherwise indicated, please make checks payable to Doylestown Township.

Why Separate Checks... For your benefit: With a single check, one or more programs may be full and the entire registration is held until we receive proper payment. Classes may be full before we can resolve the problem.

Waiting Lists: Waiting lists do not guarantee you a spot. You will be contacted only if a space becomes available. If notified, you will have 24 hours to accept the space (with payment) or the opening will be offered to the next person on the list.

Registration Confirmations: Confirmations are not issued unless a self-addressed stamped envelope is included with registration materials.

Register Early: Waiting may result in a program being canceled due to low enrollment.

Insufficient Funds: A \$35 charge will be charged back to the participant for each returned check. Failure to correct this error in a timely fashion (cash only) will result in removal from the program.

Pavilion Rentals: Two picnic shelters are available for rental in Central Park. Facility Use Application, insurance, rental fees and security deposit are required. Fees vary depending on group size and residency. Reservations may be made beginning January 1st (Township Residents) & April 1st (Non-Residents). Please call for times and availability.

Kids' Castle Group Days: Group days have been established for ALL groups regardless of size. Groups that have not pre-registered will be asked to leave the playground. Exceptions will not be made to this policy.

Groups Days: Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday from 10:00 am to 3:00 pm; May 1st- November 1st (no exceptions).

- All groups must be pre-registered.
- Playground is designed for **ages 2-12 only**.
- Fee: \$4/person fee; Payment is due upon arrival.
- An 8:1 child/chaperone ratio is required.
- Group Day registration does not include pavilion.

Refund Policy: Refund requests will be handled according to the following guidelines.

- Full refunds are issued for programs that are canceled by the township.

All refunds are issued by Township check in accordance with the Township's regular payment schedule. *No cash refunds.*

- A \$10 administrative fee will be deducted for all refund requests *up to two-weeks* prior to the start of any program.

A \$15 administrative fee will be deducted for all refund requests *within two-weeks* prior to the start of any program.

No refunds will be issued after the start of a program.

In the event of illness, written documentation from a physician will be required. Approved refunds will be prorated to reflect attendance and issued as an account credit only.

- Trip programs: Refunds are issued only if the seat can be re-sold or if the trip is canceled.
- Exceptions may exist for programs that run cooperatively with outside providers and may include non-refundable fees.
