During this Lenten season KCSS students are participating in a Penny Challenge. This collection will be divided between 2 charities. The local charity chosen is St. Vincent De Paul in Kaukauna and the international charity is Cross Catholic Outreach. Cross Catholic Outreach is a Catholic relief and development organization working in more than two dozen developing countries. In addition to providing material aid such as food, clothing, shelter and medicines, Cross Catholic Outreach supports ongoing programs that help the poor lift themselves out of poverty and thus break its vicious cycle. #### The Colors of Lent

On Ash Wednesday large crosses were put on display at Holy Cross and at St. Aloysius campuses. Let us learn to say sorry to God for the things we do that hurt Him and try to become better people as we try to follow the example of Jesus.

# Counselor Corner

## Hello KCSS Families,

I'm excited to share that KCSS students have completed learning about our fourth Character Trait: Fairness. The 6th Grade did a fantastic job illustrating famous quotes about fairness. The 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Leader of the Week students were asked to share how they demonstrate fairness and their answers were displayed in the hallway. At St. Al's, the 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade was responsible for the Guidance Bulletin Board. They wrote how they can be fair to each other and drew beautiful pictures to illustrate their ideas.


In addition to these displays, other grades participated in many other fun activities such as fairness court, fairness tic-tac-toe, and conflict resolution problem-solving. During this unit there were also some guest presentations on bullying. Some of the grades received individual lessons on bullying from guest speaker Carla Hales (the other grades have presentations scheduled for March). She engaged the classes by having them participate directly in activities and reflect on their own actions. She also came in with the Zero Tolerance Performance Group for a special presentation on bullying awareness for middle school students. The students were very touched by the stories and skits that were performed.

Last week the students started learning about the fifth Character Trait: Fairness. The 7<sup>th</sup> Grade has written creative Prayers of Citizenship, which will be displayed on the Holy Cross Bulletin Board. The 1<sup>st</sup> Grade has learned about the United States Flag, and constructed their own class flag by writing about why they are proud of being a KCSS Citizen. This is posted on the Guidance Bulletin Board at St. Al's. During this character trait, students will also learn what it means to be a good citizen at home, in school, and in the community. They will learn about what it means to be an American citizen, and some grades will be quizzed on their knowledge about our country. Other activities will include analyzing news coverage for bias, citizenship court, fables teaching citizenship, and citizenship role-playing.




