Young Performers Institute 2013

General Information

Young Performers Institute 2013 is designed for rising 7th -10th graders. It will run Monday-Friday, July 29th - August 9th from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM.

The tuition fee of the camp is \$525 per camper, which includes a Young Performers Institute T-shirt, daily snack, supplies, and materials for all workshops, as well as two tickets to the final Showcase. We offer a \$50 Discount per additional sibling.

We offer an extended day option, which is designed for parents needing to drop campers off early or pick them up later. Our 8:00 AM – 9:00 AM or 4:00 PM – 5:00 PM options cost \$70 each, or you can choose both for \$120.

Registration, deposit payment, and full payment can all be made either online or by check.

Registration Process

1. Registration can be performed one of two ways.

OPTION A: Registration can be performed online at http://va-rep.org/camps summer.html. Please print and sign the Medical Release Form and the Camper Behavior and Discipline Agreement and have the child bring the signed forms to the first day of camp.

OPTION B: Please fill out and mail the completed Young Performers Institute Registration Form, signed Medical Release Form, and signed Camper Contract of Agreement.

2. Deposit

OPTION A: Deposit Payment can be performed online at http://varep.org/camps summer.html

OPTION B: Enclose a check of \$100 per child with the registration form. You MUST pay your deposit to hold each child's spot. Registration alone does not guarantee enrollment until the deposit has been paid. ENROLLMENT IS BASED ON A FIRST-PAID, FIRST-SERVED BASIS.

3. Payment of Remaining Balance

OPTION A: Payment of the remaining balance can be made online at http://va-rep.org/camps_summer.html

OPTION B: Only one Tuition Payment Form needs to be filled out per family, per session. We ask that if you have multiple children attending this session that payment be made in a lump sum. Payments may be made with a credit card, check or money order. A 3% convenience fee will be added to all credit card charges. Please make all checks payable to **Virginia Repertory Theatre** and write your child(ren)'s name in the memo blank of your check. **Tuition must be paid in full by July 15**th **to finalize registration.**

- **4. Financial Assistance:** All Financial Assistance Applications must be in by Friday, May 31st, 2013. Financial Assistance Applications must be accompanied with a \$25 reduced-rate non-refundable deposit for each camper registering. Financial Assistance decisions will be made no later than Thursday, June 13th, 2013. We have limited funds to assist children and families in attending our Stage Explorers programs. The majority of financial assistance is funded by the generous gifts of parents and donors. In order to make sure we are able to assist as many families as possible, please limit your application to two children per year.
- **5. Refunds and Withdraws:** Your \$100 deposit is non-refundable. Refunds of all fees (except the \$100 deposit) will be made if cancellation is received in written form no

later than **May 17th**. Should a participant have to withdraw due to a medical emergency, injury, or other crisis, refunds (if any) are minimal and will be made at the sole discretion of Virginia Repertory Theatre.

6. Young Artists Fund: Virginia Repertory Theatre is committed to providing enriching opportunities such as Young Performers Institute to children and families in the Greater Richmond Area who would be otherwise unable to afford them. 75% of Richmond City K-12 students apply for free/reduced priced lunches. We aim to invite these students to grow and learn through Young Performers Institute alongside their peers, but we need your help. Through our Young Artists Fund, you can give the gift of art, education, and fun to Richmond's most wonderful and talented underprivileged youth. Please see the Young Artists Fund donation sheet if you wish to take part in enhancing and enriching the lives of these young artists. The donation sheet may either be turned in with a camper's tuition payment, or separately. We encourage you to make all contributions by May 17th, 2013 in order for Virginia Repertory Theatre to distribute all funds accurately. However, donations will continue to be accepted year-round.

Camp Rules

- 1. **Clothing:** All campers must wear comfortable clothes suited for movement. They will participate in dance, acting, and other movement workshops and, therefore, cannot wear restricting clothing. Campers must wear tennis shoes. Campers may bring jazz/ballet shoes if they already have them, but they are not required. No sandals, heels, roller shoes, crocs, or skirts are permitted. Any camper not wearing close-toed shoes will be asked to sit out of that day's instruction for safety reasons. Campers should not wear items they do not want to get dirty.
- 2. **Personal Items:** Due to the physical nature of our workshops, we ask that campers not bring jewelry. Any and all personal items need to be individually labeled. You will not be able to lock up any valuables during camp. Space is limited, so please have your campers bring only what is needed for camp. No electronic items (including cell phones, handheld games, etc.) are allowed to be turned on at camp. Virginia Repertory Theatre is not responsible for any lost or stolen items.
- 3. **Food:** There will be a 30 min. lunch break each day; please bring a bagged lunch every day, as meals will not be provided. Please pack a water bottle for your child to bring to camp each day. We will provide a snack during the day. Snacks and soda will be available at our concession stand for one dollar. Please identify any special dietary needs or concerns, as well as allergy issues, on your registration form.
- 4. **Schedule:** Young Performers Institute is a day camp and will run Monday-Friday from 9:00am-4:00pm. We do offer an extended day option for parents who need to drop campers off early or pick them up later. Please see the registration form for pricing. Classes will start promptly at 9:00am each morning. It is important that your child arrive on time each day so that he/she does not miss any important instruction or rehearsal time. This is a group-oriented camp, and it is important that campers remain part of the team, working together to achieve similar goals in theatre. It is disruptive to enter a class late and will affect the group work being developed. It is important to us to respect your time as well; to ensure that your pick-up runs as smoothly and efficiently as possible, our instruction will not go past 4:00pm each day. Due to the nature of the group activity, we cannot allow your child to miss important instruction or rehearsal time. Outside of an emergency, we ask that your child remain in camp for its entire duration.
- 5. **Young Performers Showcase:** At the end of each camp session all campers will perform/participate in a final Young Performers Showcase. The performance will take place on the final Friday of camp from 4:00pm-5:00pm. The campers will have an opportunity to display and perform everything they've learned, created, and

- experienced throughout their camp session. Camp tuition includes two tickets to the final Showcase; any additional tickets may be purchased for \$5 during the camp session.
- 6. **Pick-Up/Drop-Off**: Please park in the Willow Lawn parking lot to drop off/pick up your child. You may not park in the fire lane outside of the theatre due to congestion and safety issues. You must come inside to pick up your child. No child will be released to an unknown adult. If someone other than the parent/guardian will be picking up your child, you must contact the Camp Director for approval. Your child's safety is our primary concern. On the first day of camp we will be holding a brief camp orientation from 9:00-9:25am. We encourage parents to attend the initial orientation, as we will be introducing our Staff and Teaching Artists, as well as going over important camp rules and information.
- 7. **Cell Phones/Emergency Contact**: Children will not be allowed to have cell phones or other electronic devices turned on at camp, as they can disrupt the group activity. They may carry a phone with them to contact you in case of emergency. Should you need to reach your child during the camp, please contact the Camp Director.

- 4. Abusive, violent, or unsafe behavior
- 5. Bullying of any kind
- 6. Refusal to obey authority or follow directions
- 7. Disrespect to peers and/or staff
