

## Call for Nominations NLMA Board of Directors

The NLMA Nominating Committee will be meeting late in February and physicians wishing to have themselves considered for nomination to the NLMA Board of Directors, or who would like to nominate a colleague, should contact the NLMA office by **February 23, 2007.** 

We will require two (2) representatives from the St. John's region, one (1) from the Avalon region, one (1) from the Peninsulas Region, one (1) from the Western region and one (1) from the Grenfell region, as well as nominees for **Honorary Secretary** and **President-Elect**.
