


Audubon Society's Collection: Celebrating 35 years at the Main Library

CreationStation Teen Time

The Creation Station at the Main Library is the place to find the latest digital tools to create and edit music and video.

Teen Time in the CreationStation provides the opportunity for teens to develop their skills or learn the basics concerning video and audio production, graphic design, photography and other forms of digital media that may interest them.

CreationStation mentors are on hand to assist during Teen Time with the use of professional software, such as: Final Cut Pro for video production, Photoshop to edit images, GarageBand or Logic Pro X for music, and Manga Studio for designing professional quality comics and illustrations. Teen Time participants can use video cameras, stage lighting and a green screen to record video, microphones for sound recording or even a drawing tablet to create whatever they can imagine.

During previous Teen Times, we've taken studio portraits then added filters and effects to make them look aged and damaged, recorded podcasts and added sound effects and filmed in front of the green screen then replaced that background with other locations such as the streets of New York.

Teens, grades 6-12 are encouraged to stop by during Teen Time, regardless of skill level or interest.




