## Terms & Conditions Governing Siemens SCE Program

These terms and conditions apply to your application to the Siemens SCE Program and to your participation therein.

1. Program Participants may only install and use the SCE program (the “Program”) software on school or student computers as defined and limited by the license structure of the purchased product. Furthermore, any single license for software may not be shared, replicated or used on different computers at the same time.
2. The use of the hardware and software purchased through the Program is only permitted within the framework of training and education at Program Participant’s facility. Giving away, hiring out, leasing, loaning or the resale of the hardware, software or licenses purchased through the Program is not permitted.
3. The SCE program is limited to Not-for-Profit Educational Institutions and shall be not be used for commercial training activities. Program Participants are required to offer educational services which are accessible to the general public without exclusion.
4. Program Participant users (students and/or teachers) may install and use the STEP7 for Students software, licensed for 365 days, on their private computers for use exclusively in school related learning and lab exercises; the software may not be given to any third parties. The users (students or teachers) will be provided by the Institution, a copy of the original software product certificate including the school's stamp and signature, which is deemed to be proof of rightful purchase and use. The use of this software relates to the licenses duly acquired in conjunction with the SIMATIC STEP7 Trainer Package.
5. In addition to the restrictions contained herein, the General License Conditions for Software Products shall apply as enclosed with each software product. Siemens reserves the right to perform inspections to ensure that Program Participant is complying with all program and software license obligations. Violations of these stipulations and of a license agreement shall be prosecuted, where appropriate, under criminal and civil law.
6. Siemens reserves the right to change program pricing, part numbers hardware and software revisions without notice. Siemens reserves the right to obsolete, discontinue or otherwise limit program parts, product revisions and support services as necessary. Institutions are encouraged to purchase an optional Software Subscription Service for routine software upgrades.
7. Both Siemens and Program Participant have the option to terminate program participation upon 30 days written notice or with mutual written consent.
