



Thank you for your interest in becoming a vendor at the 2016 Pittsburgh Vintage Grand Prix. With over 250,000 spectators, it is the ultimate Western PA event to showcase your products and services. Founded in 1983 the PVGP has grown to become the country's largest vintage race event and the only one run on city streets. Our Schenley Park Race Weekend occurs on July 16/17.



Each vendor spot now includes a PVGP supplied hi-peak white tent with a backwall. Three sizes of tents (10' x 10', 15' x 15' and 16' x 24') are available. This greatly improves appearance and set-up while increasing traffic flow through the entire Vendor Village area. Tables, chairs, tent sidewalls and electricity will be available for rent and will be in your tent when you arrive.

The backwall provides you with an area behind your tent to park your support vehicle. If you have a second vehicle or a vehicle longer than 15 feet you will not be able to park them behind your tent. If you have your own tent, display or custom trailer that you feel you must use to vend please contact the Grand Prix to discuss an optional location.

We have two additional venues for vendors to participate. Our PVGP Historics at Pitt-Race Complex in Beaver County provide a Vendor Village during the July 9/10 race weekend. Spaces are only \$250 and over 5,000 spectators are expected. Our popular Car Cruise at the Waterfront in Homestead occurs on Tuesday, July 14 and draws a large crowd that's already in a shopping mood. Spaces are just \$200 each. Sorry, these two venues do not include tents, electrical power or offer quantity discounts.

You must be moved out by 8:00 PM Sunday. Sales begin at 9 AM and close at 5:00 PM each day. This village is on a golf course so your display cannot involve RV's, heavy equipment or building materials. Please call to discuss if your display involves more than a tent, table and chairs.

- _____ **Medium Vendor Tent** 15' x 15' Hi-Peak tent with 15' backwall - **\$1,025.00**
- _____ **Large Vendor Tent** 16' x 24' Hi-Peak tent with 24' backwall - **\$2,095.00**
- _____ **Corner Spot** Allows vending out of all sides of tent - **\$100.00**
- _____ **Tent sidewall** Fits all tents, can be tied back - **\$25.00 each**
- _____ **Tables** 6 foot banquet tables - **\$10.00 each**
- _____ **Chairs** Brown metal and plastic chairs - **\$2.50 each**
- _____ **Electrical Power** 5 kW gas generator (PVGP to supply fuel) will be within 30 feet of your tent - **\$150.00**
- _____ **Vehicle for Sale** Space for your vehicle only, does not include room for a tent - **\$150.00 per vehicle**
