Please note that <u>incomplete application forms and requirements will not be considered</u>. Documents submitted will also become the property of the organization and will not be returned to the applicants.

### THE BYLP AND ITS OBJECTIVES

The BYLP is inspired by the Ayala Young Leaders Congress, a national youth congress attended by chosen young leaders all over the country.

Each of the 11 municipalities and 2 cities of Basilan shall have youth representatives.

The program is a 28-day journey that aims to engage, expose, equip, empower, immerse, inspire and involve the next-generation leaders of Basilan. It features plenary discussions, workshops, teambuilding activities, educational tours and institutional visits to various important sites and locations all over the country.



# PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY

To apply for the BYLP, the applicant must:

- 1. Be a Filipino citizen, 18-30 years of age at the time of the Program (March 9, 2015)
- 2. Be a bona fide resident of the Province of Basilan
- 3. Must not have been subjected to any disciplinary case nor have been charged and/or convicted in a civil or criminal case.
- 4. Be a recognized, active, and effective youth leader or officer in:
  - Recognized school organizations (e.g. student government, co-curricular, extra-curricular, cause oriented, religious organizations)
  - Community organizations (e.g. Local Government units, religious-based Organizations, Socio-Civic Groups, Volunteer Organizations, etc.)
- 5. Be a model of integrity, discipline, excellence
- 6. Must have sincere desire to serve and a passion to bring about positive change in society

### PROGRAM APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

The applicant must submit all of the following documents:

- A fully completed application form
   The Secretariat will be distributing copies of application form on February 2-3,
   2015 at certain areas in Basilan. Applicants can also download a copy of the application forms from the ARMM Website (<a href="http://armm.gov.ph">http://armm.gov.ph</a>)
- 2. <u>FOR CURRENTLY ENROLLED STUDENTS ONLY</u>: A certified true copy of the applicant's college Evaluation Sheet for all undergraduate course work, ending with the grades from the first semester of SY 2014-2015
- 3. Barangay Clearance or Mayor's Clearance (signifying that the applicant is a resident of the respective barangay/municipality/city)
- 4. Police Clearance or NBI Clearance
- 5. Certifications supporting leadership experience, awards received and community involvements.
- 6. A signed recommendation letter.
- 7. Personal essay or artwork

All application documents submitted will become the property of the BYLP Secretariat and will NOT be returned to the applicants.

Completed applications should be submitted on February 13, 2015 at Basilan State College. Seal your application forms and requirements in a long brown envelope labelled BYLP 2015 Application with Name and Address at the back.

Essay. Your essay must be original and has not been previously printed in any publication or submitted as a requirement for any school subject. Submit a one-page, 350 word, handwritten essay on a 8.5x11 inch short bond paper.

Artwork. Your artwork must be original and has not won previously in any contest. Submit an 8.5"x11" artwork using any medium of your choice (pencil, watercolour, etc). On a separate sheet of paper, write a brief description of your artwork. (Maximum of 100 words).





### RECOMMENDATION LETTER

#### To the Applicant:

Choose one (1) evaluator, either academe or non-academic, who will write a recommendation letter for you.

The academe evaluator can be any of the following:

- 1. Class Advisor
- 2. School Guidance Counselor / Student Affairs Officer
- 3. School Principal / Dean
- 4. Adviser of a school-based organization, where the applicant is a member of
- 5. Teacher/Professor of the applicant in at least one subject

The non-academe evaluator can be anyone from the community (parish priest, imam, barangay captain/councillor, or any person with authority who can vouch for the potential and ability of the applicant. NOTE: The Evaluator must NOT be related to the applicant either by consanguinity or affinity.

Ask your Evaluator to write a recommendation letter, answering the following questions below. Your Evaluators should sign the recommendation letter and put it inside a white letter envelope. The letter envelope should be sealed, signed across the flap and returned to you.

The sealed envelope should be enclosed together with your completed application. Please note that <u>unsigned and unsealed recommendation letters</u> will not be honoured.

#### To the Evaluators

Your candid assessment of the applicant will assist the screening committee of the BYLP 2015. We greatly appreciate your time and effort in writing a recommendation. This recommendation is to be returned to the applicant. Please seal and sign the back flap of the envelope.

On your professional letterhead, please type or write a one-page recommendation for the applicant, answering the following items below:

- 1. How long have you known the applicant and in what connection?
- 2. What do you consider the applicant's talents or strengths?
- 3. What do you consider the applicant's weaknesses or areas of improvement?
- 4. Would you endorse the applicant for the BYLP? Why or why not?
- 5. Please feel free to provide any additional information about the applicant's record, potential or personal qualities, which you believe would be helpful to the Selection Committee in considering this person's application.
