Each club is entitled to speak at the meeting and have a coach representative cast a single vote All SEDA members (debaters, parents, teachers and other coaches) are strongly encouraged to attend the AGM, as everyone's voices are important. Social activities will be arranged for debaters at the same time as the AGM. Why: This is an exciting opportunity to have input on SEDA policy, discuss important issues facing clubs and meet other coaches from across the province. What: The Agenda includes approval of the Audit, election of Directors, and issues such as the partnership rules, bracketing, judging requirements, parents and alumni associations and the new communications policy. Contact SEDA beforehand if you have an issue to add to the agenda.

SEDA has three open spots for Board members. Nominations can be made ahead of time by contacting the SEDA office or at the time of the meeting. Nominees must be 18 years or older and associated with one of the member clubs.

Conditions
