REGULATIONS

The 22 players (all players suiting up if less than 22) who suited up for the last district game. The GPA shall be based on grades from the preceding semester. (Non-traditional semester: An approximate 18-week grading period used to divide the school year in half.) The state champion shall be the team with the highest GPA for their respective class.

- A. Teams must meet all qualifications required of the respective activity in order to qualify.
- B. Entries received after the entry deadline will not be considered. Incorrect information submitted on the entry form will alos void the entry. Please report any corrections or changes on your academic application to the OSSAA office. The OSSAA will confirm finalists for the state championship award.
- C. The academic GPA will be based on a 4 point system and computed to the nearest thousandth percentile: A=4.; B=3.000; C=2.000; D=1.000. If you have a weighted grading system it must be converted to a 4 point system in computing the team GPA.
- D. All classes that count toward graduation shall be used in determining each individual students GPA.
- A. Academic achievement certificate: Teams must have a minimum 3.25 GPA and rank in the upper 1/3 of their classification to qualify.
- B. Distringuished academic plaque: Teams must have a minimum 3.50 GPA and rank in the upper 10% of their classification.
- C. State Academic Champion: The team with the highest qualifying GPA will be declared the state academic champion for their respective class.
