ENTRY FEES:

- ☐ SCSPGA Golf Professionals in good standing. Entry fee \$500
- Amateurs-2.6 Index or less. Entry fee \$450
- □ Non PGA Golf Professionals. Entry Fee \$600 This includes all Foreign Tour Players and PGA or Apprentice Professionals NOT in good standing with the PGA of America or their respective PGA Sections.
- ☐ PGA or PGA Apprentices, in good standing, residing outside of Sun Country PGA. Entry Fee \$550.
- □ Pro-Am entry fee- \$100 (Professionals Only)

ALL ENTRY FEES INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING:

- 2 rounds of golf including cart and range balls.
- 1 round of golf including cart and range balls. This is provided that you make the final cut and ties.
- 3 nights lodging at the Inn of the Mountain Gods Resort (first 175) or the Lodge at Sierra Blanca (after the first 175 entries)
- \$50 food voucher which can used at any food establishment on the property of the Inn of the Mountain Gods Resort and Casino. Not good for casino wagering.

AMATEUR ELIGIBILITY:

• All Amateurs with a Handicap Index of 2.6 or lower as of last handicap posting. The amateur field will be limited to the first 20 entries.

PURSES

- The Professional Purse will be \$65,000 based on a full field of 156. The Field will be cut to Low 50 (based on a full field) and ties after 36 holes. Amateurs will be included in the cut. Payoff can be viewed on the New Mexico Open web site at www.nmopen.com. The tournament committee reserves the right to adjust the purse if a full field is not met.
- The Amateur Purse will be based on the number of entries- 100% of net entry fees. Must make the cut to win merchandise.

PRO-AM:

• The Charity Pro-Am is Tuesday, September 8. Professional entry fee: \$100, which includes golf, cart and range.

Two shotguns: One in the morning and afternoon at the Inn of the Mountain Gods GC. To enter and for more information, call the Inn of the Mountain Gods Golf Shop at 575-464-7941. All net proceeds from the Celebrity/Charity Pro-Am will be donated to the Big Brothers, Big Sisters of SE New Mexico and the Sun Country Junior Golf Foundation Scholarship fund.

PRACTICE ROUND:

• Scheduled for September 7 at the Inn of the Mountain Gods. Call the Inn of the Mountain Gods Golf Shop at 575-464-7445. A \$25 fee will be charged.

PRACTICE RANGE:

• The practice range at the Inn of the Mountain Gods is for warm-up purposes and has limited flight. For practice, please use the practice range at the Links of Sierra Blanca located approximately 20 minutes from the golf course. There is **no charge** to New Mexico Open participants. Location: 105 Sierra Blanca Dr., Ruidoso, NM, 505-258-5330. Starting Tuesday at 6:30 a.m. and ending Friday at 10:00 a.m.

RULES OF GOLF:

• USGA Rules of Golf, Sun Country PGA Hard Card and the SCS PGA Tournament Regulations shall govern play except as modified by local rules.

CARTS/GROUPINGS:

• All groups will be issued two carts. You are not required to ride a cart but are encouraged to do so. However, if the rules committee deems you to be out of position, you will be required to ride until you have regained your position. All pairings will be in groups of two or three. Two carts only per group.

AMATEUR GIFT CERTIFICATES:

• Gift Certificates won by amateur participants are redeemable at the Inn of the Mountain Gods Golf Club Golf Shop.

WITHDRAWALS AND REFUNDS:

• No refunds will be given after the pairings are made. (Friday, September 4, @ 4:30 p.m.). All refunds prior to the deadline will be charged a \$30 administrative fee.

ACCOMMODATIONS:

• All accommodations, for a maximum of 3 nights, September 8, 9 and 10 are included in the entry fee. Reservations will be made in your name. Please present a credit card when you check-in to cover any incidentals or extra nights. Call the Resort at 800-446-2963 for rate quotes for any other days.
