BLACKFRIARS GENERAL EXCELLENCE SCHOLARSHIP

Blackfriars Priory School offers General Excellence Scholarships annually to students entering Year 8 to Year 11. The scholarship program exists to foster diversity by ensuring that an education at Blackfriars is available to as wide a range of students as possible. Our scholarship program seeks to offer places to students who will contribute to the richness and diversity of the school's community.

Applicants must be in Year 7 to Year 10 at the time of application. The scholarship is open to internal and external students. The scholarship is awarded to a student who has an outstanding academic ability which is supported by a particular talent in an additional area.

Applications must be received by 30 October, 2015. Short listed applicants will be notified and asked to meet with the Principal for a short interview. The scholarship will be awarded on recommendation of the Scholarship Committee and at the discretion of the Principal.

The school will acknowledge the successful, outstanding applicant by contributing up to 50% of the student's tuition fees for the year in which the scholarship is awarded (not applicable to other fees and levies). Successful and unsuccessful applicants are welcome to re-apply in subsequent years. The successful applicants will receive a framed certificate acknowledging this achievement.

The successful applicant may be asked to speak at a school assembly or gathering as a scholarship recipient. The successful applicants will be photographed and acknowledged in school publications and on the website.
